***ERASMUS+* PROGRAMME FOR STUDY AND RESEARCH
CALL FOR APPLICATION**



ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-2021
APPLICATION DEADLINE: 17 MARCH 2020

§ 1 – General Information

The Erasmus+ Programme for Study and Research enables SNS students to spend consecutive time periods at a partner higher education institution for study or research purposes.

Erasmus+ students can attend courses and use the hosting institution's facilities, and are exempted from any tuition fee (with the only exemption of any eventual fee that local students are also required to pay). Students are guaranteed full recognition of the assessed learning activities carried out abroad, on the condition that they were approved in advance with the signature of the *Learning Agreement*.

Erasmus+ mobilities can be funded with a study grant by the European Union (see § 3), or they can be activated as 'zero-grant' mobilities.

§ 2 – Eligible Countries

Erasmus+ mobilities can be activated towards higher education institutions based in one of the following Programme Countries:

- the other 27 EU Member States: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, and United Kingdom;
- the 3 additional countries of the European Economic Area (EEA): Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway;
- accession candidate countries: Turkey, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia.

BREXIT: Mobility to the United Kingdom has also been confirmed for the 2020-2021 academic year.

§ 3 – Funding

Erasmus+ students may benefit of the following funds:

- a) the ***European Union grant (Erasmus+ funding programme)***. The amount depends on the destination country and the number of days actually spent abroad. Specifically, funding is divided into destination country groups based on the cost of living:

GROUP 1 (HIGH cost of living)	Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Ireland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden, United Kingdom	€ 300 per month
GROUP 2 (MEDIUM cost of living)	Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Germany, Greece, Netherlands, Malta, Portugal, Spain	€ 250 per month
GROUP 3 (LOW cost of living)	Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia	€ 250 per month

b) an **additional grant of € 200.00 per month for students with disadvantaged socio-economic backgrounds (Erasmus+ funding programme)** (*);

c) an **additional grant for students with special needs (Erasmus+ funding programme)**, pending verification and decided on a case-by-case basis;

d) a **supplementary contribution of € 500.00 per month**, including the eventual integration provided by the so-called “fondo Giovani” for the whole Erasmus+ mobility. The right to this contribution depends on the funding allocated by the 2020 budget (*).

Students are not allowed to ask their Faculty’s Mobility Board for additional grants, unless they are only benefiting from the European grant under letter a), or they activated a ‘zero-grant’ mobility.

Any grant described above is intended for the performance of eligible activities abroad (see § 8 “Activities to Be Carried Out Abroad and Learning Agreement”), during a mobility of **at least 3 months and up to 12 months**. The mobility period is to start after 1 August 2020 and to be comprised of consecutive months. All the above-mentioned contributions are subject to submission of the Learning Agreement and to recognition by the SNS of the activities performed.

(*). Successful candidates are required to submit the ISEEU certification by 15 May 2020 in order to determine the amount of the grant described under letter b) and d).

The total amount of the contribution granted will be communicated by 15 June 2020.

§ 4 – Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible candidates for the *ERASMUS+ Programme for Study and Research* in the academic year 2020/2021, students, regardless of their nationality, must:

1. Be enrolled at the SNS for the current academic year;

PLEASE NOTE: SNS students from countries participating in the ERASMUS+ Programme are eligible for mobilities towards a higher education institute based in their country of origin, provided they are no longer residents of said country. However, in the selection process, priority will be given to other candidates. Moreover, in order to accept the position, they will need to obtain a certificate of no impediment from the host institution.

2. Possess adequate language skills (see § 6 “Language Requirements”);

3. Submit a study plan illustrating the activities to be performed at the host institution (see § 8 “Activities to Be Carried Out Abroad and Learning Agreement”);

4. Obtain the favourable opinion of their supervisor (undergraduate students) or course coordinator (PhD students);

5. **NOT graduate** before the end of the mobility and the recognition of the activities carried out abroad.

§ 5 - Incompatibilities

Under the ERASMUS+ Programme, students may activate mobilities for study and research or for traineeship during any study cycle (undergraduate, graduate and doctorate) and for a total period of time that does not exceed twelve months in each cycle. Any earlier mobility activated in the same cycle must be taken into account for this calculation.

Successful candidates may not activate, during the same period of an Erasmus+ mobility, any other kind of mobility under different programmes.

Erasmus+ students benefiting from the EU grant cannot receive, during the same period, any other type of funds from the European Union.

§ 6 – Language Requirements

Potential candidates for an Erasmus+ mobility are required to check the language requirements set by the host institution of their choice and listed in ANNEX A.

When submitting their application, students may demonstrate to possess an adequate level in the language required either by attaching a language certificate or by [self-certification](#).

§ 7 - Destinations

Erasmus+ mobilities can be activated towards any institution listed in ANNEX A, which contains all the details regarding eligible subjects of study (*by 2013 ISCED code*), number and type of positions available, submission deadlines and language requirements.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Regardless of the approval of an Erasmus application by the SNS, it is still possible for successful candidates to be rejected by the hosting institution of their choice. This may depend on different factors (deadlines not met, unconfirmed language skills, impractical study plans). Requirements may differ year by year and each hosting institution reserves the right to accept or reject an application.

§ 8 – Activities to Be Carried Out Abroad and Learning Agreement

In order to benefit from the status of Erasmus student, and from the relative grant, it is necessary for a specific Erasmus study plan (known as Learning Agreement) to be approved by the host institution **before the beginning of the mobility**.

The compatibility of the activities planned with the **internal obligations** of the SNS must be confirmed in advance by the study plan supervisor or the Phd course coordinator and the Faculty Council of each candidate. For this reason, any activity to be carried out abroad, including research for a thesis, must be included in the SNS study plan for the academic year of the mobility.

At the end of the mobility, any activity performed, course attended and exam given abroad will be **recognised** based on the certification submitted.

Successful students will receive the Learning Agreement forms from the SNS Internationalization Office. The Learning Agreement will list all the pre-approved activities, e.g.:

- Full-time learning activities (courses to be attended abroad);
- Research for the preparation of a thesis.

Upon request, it is possible to make changes to the Learning Agreement while the mobility is in progress, as long as any change is previously agreed on with all the parts involved.

Undergraduate students may only list full-time study and research activity for the preparation of their thesis coherently with their study curriculum at the Scuola Normale Superiore.

§ 9 – Documentation to be Submitted at the End of the Mobility

At the end of the mobility, Erasmus+ students have up to 5 weeks to send the Internationalization Office the Learning Agreement filled and signed by the host institution. In particular, the document must contain detailed information on the actual days of permanence in the host institution and on the activities performed.

Recognition of any activity performed abroad and listed in the Learning Agreement is contingent on the fulfilment of the above requirement. In absence of any documentation, any sum already corresponded will have to be reimbursed.

§ 10 – Deadlines and Application Procedure

Applications must be sent **online through the SER.SE. platform** (please see instructions in ANNEX B).

Candidates must attach to their application a motivation letter and a language certificate, which, in this phase, may be replaced by a self-certification (please see § 6).

All applications will be automatically submitted to the approval of a supervisor and will have to be completed by **17 March 2020**.

§ 11 – Award Criteria

An interfaculty mobility board will evaluate all the applications received and create a ranked list.

In particular, the award criteria are the following:

- **Up to 70 points out of 100** for the motivations expressed by each candidate in their motivation letter;
- **Up to 30 points out of 100** for certificated language skills.

For those students who already benefited from a previous Erasmus+ mobility during the same study cycle or a previous study cycle, **20 points will be deducted** from the total score.

In the event of a tie, priority will be given to the younger candidate.

§ 12 – Acceptance, Withdrawal, and Replacement

The selection procedure will end on **27 March 2020**.

Within 3 days by the end of the selection, successful candidates will be notified via email by the Internationalization Office. They will then need to officially accept the position, even via email, and promptly ask for information about the application procedure to the host institution of their choice, **keeping in mind the deadlines set by the host institutions listed in Annex A.**

§ 13 – Practical Information

SNS students in outgoing mobility are always covered by an insurance policy against accidents and social liability offered by the Scuola Normale Superiore. In order to have access to health care during their permanency abroad, Erasmus students should bring their T.E.A.M. Card or get the S1 form needed to transfer their health coverage in another EU State.

Depending on their citizenships, some candidates might need a visa to enter their destination country.

Erasmus+ mobilities are not exempt from the norm regulating immigration and circulation in the European Union of extra-UE citizens.
