



**SEMP CALL FOR APPLICATION**  
**STUDY AND RESEARCH MOBILITIES TOWARDS SWISS INSTITUTIONS**  
**A.Y. 2020-2021**  
**DEADLINE 17TH MARCH 2020**

Art. 1 – The destinations indicated in the call for application to the Erasmus+ Study and Research Programme a.y. 2020-2021 are integrated with the destinations in Annex A.

Art. 2 – The positions in the present document are subject to the same conditions and prerequisites as the positions under the Erasmus+ Programme, including the limit of maximum 12 months of mobility per student per study cycle under the SEMP Programme.

Art. 3 – Swiss university offer a grant of about 360.00 CHF per month for study mobilities.

Art. 4 – In addition to the Swiss grant, SNS students participating in the SEMP Programme may be assigned a supplementary contribution of € 1,000.00 per month by the Scuola Normale Superiore, until funds from the 2019 budget are exhausted.

The SNS contribution is calculated based on the living costs and aimed at covering travel and accommodation expenses. Successful candidate will have to submit a report of expenses, in absence of which the contribution paid will be recalculated.

Students receiving the SNS contribution are not allowed to request additional funds to the Mobility Commission of their Faculty for the same period of mobility.

The contribution will be paid in two instalments:

- A first payment of the 80% of the total amount at the start of the mobility;
- A second payment covering the balance of the reported expenses upon submission of the original travel and accommodation receipts. In order to allow the payment, the Internationalisation Office will have to transmit to the Budgeting and Accounting Office a letter asking for the liquidation of the balance.

Art. 5 – Students interested in a mobility towards one of the destinations listed in Annex A can apply by filling in the documents in Annex 2 and 3.

The signed application form, together with all the requested attachments, must be submitted to the SNS “Servizio Protocollo” or sent by email in one single file to [protocollo@sns.it](mailto:protocollo@sns.it) from a @sns.it address, with [international@sns.it](mailto:international@sns.it) in Cc, by **17<sup>th</sup> March 2020**.

The sending date will be demonstrated by the email date, or, in case of hand deliveries, according to the procedures set by the *Servizio Protocollo*.

Art. 6 – Results will be advertised by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 and a ranked list will be published on the SNS website at the following page: <https://www.sns.it/en/mobility-and-internationalization/off-site-opportunities/international-calls-and-rankings>.
