## § 1 – General Information

The Erasmus+ mobility for Study programme allows SNS students to spend time abroad at a partner higher education institution for study purposes. It is also possible to plan a blended mobility consisting in a period of virtual learning to be completed with a short-term or long-term physical mobility abroad (see [§ 3](#)).

Erasmus+ students can attend courses and use the hosting institution's facilities, and are exempted from any tuition fees (with the only exemption of any eventual fees that local students are also required to pay). Students are guaranteed full recognition of the learning activities carried out abroad, on condition that they were previously approved through a specific Learning Agreement.

Erasmus+ mobilities can be funded with a study grant by the European Union (see [§ 4](#)), or they can be activated as 'zero-grant' mobilities.

## § 2 – Eligible Countries

It is possible to activate an Erasmus+ mobility for Study towards any higher education institutions based either in countries participating in the Erasmus+ programme or in third countries not associated to the Programme, as long as they have signed a mobility agreement with the Scuola.

## § 3 – Eligible Mobilities

SNS students can activate the following types of Study mobility:

- a) **Long-term mobility** with a minimum duration of at least two months and a maximum duration of twelve months. This kind of mobility is available both for students of the "corso ordinario" (Bachelor's and Master's level) and for Ph.D. students.
- b) **Blended short-term mobility** for students of the corso ordinario (Bachelor's and Master's level). This is a combination of a short-term physical mobility (5 to 30 days) with a compulsory virtual component. A blended mobility for studies must award a minimum of 3 ECTS credits.
- c) **Short-term mobility for doctoral candidates**. From 5 to 30 days of physical mobility with no compulsory virtual component nor a minimum requirement of ECTS.

All kinds of mobility must start after the **1st August, 2024**.

Any study period abroad of any duration may include a virtual component, that can take place before, during or after the physical mobility.

Students will not receive any grants for the virtual part of the mobility, and the virtual period will not add towards the maximum length of Erasmus+ mobility per study cycle. Any activities performed virtually will be fully recognized by the Scuola Normale.

## § 4 – Funding

### **FUNDED POSITIONS**

Erasmus+ students may benefit from the following funds:

- a) the European Union grant for **individual support (Erasmus+ funding programme)**, whose monthly amount is based on the destination country and calculated on the basis of actual days of mobility abroad. Programme Countries have been divided into three different groups based on the cost of living, while third countries not associated to the Programme have been gathered in the same group, with the only exception of regions 13 and 14<sup>1</sup>. Pending the confirmation of the individual support amount for the 2024 edition, we publish below, only for reference, the monthly amount per destination country for the past 2023 edition.

- b) when applicable, based on national regulations<sup>3</sup> and upon mandatory submission, **within the deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024**, of an ISEE certificate, and/or a self-declaration proving the existence of one of the foreseen circumstances, **a top-up amount to individual support for students and recent graduates with fewer opportunities (Erasmus+ funding programme)**, equal to EUR 250 per month for long-term physical mobility, in addition to the contribution under point a).

Students with fewer opportunities in short-term physical mobility will be entitled to the following overall top-up amount:

- participants with documented physical, mental and health issues;
- participants from a disadvantaged socio-economical background documented by an ISEE certification (according to the indications that will be subsequently published by the National Authority (MUR));
- participants with cultural differences, e.g. with migratory background, refugees, ethnic or national minorities, with difficulties in linguistic adaptation and cultural inclusion;
- students with underage children;
- working students;
- students who are professional athletes;
- orphans of at least one parent;
- victims of terrorism and organized crime.

- c) When applicable, a travel grant (Erasmus+ funding programme) according to rules and amounts to be announced following the publication of the National Provisions for the year 2024.).
- d) a **supplementary contribution (SNS funding)** of 560 EUR per month, including the eventual integration provided by the so-called “fondo Giovani”, for the whole Erasmus+ mobility. The SNS supplementary contribution constitutes income and is subject to IRPEF taxation.

Students benefitting from the contribution under letter e) are not allowed to request additional grants to their Faculty’s Mobility Committee, unless they have been assigned a zero-grant mobility.

Any grant described above is meant for carrying out eligible activities abroad (see [§10](#) “Activities to Be Carried Out Abroad and Learning Agreement”).

The above-mentioned contributions are subject to the submission of the Learning Agreement and to the recognition by the SNS of the activities performed.

N.B.: Ph.D. students whose Ph.D. scholarship is funded by EC funds can only receive the contribution under letter e).

**NON-FUNDED POSITIONS (ZERO GRANT) – PLEASE SEE ANNEX B**

In order to have activities performed abroad recognised on their curriculum at the University of Pisa, students from the “corsi ordinari” (Bachelor’s and Master’s level) who already submitted an

application under the call for international exchange positions published by the Scuola for the following destinations:

- École Normale Supérieure in Paris
- École Normale Supérieure in Lyon
- Dresden Technische Universitaet

can also apply for **non-funded positions (zero grant)** under the present call.

### § 5 Inclusion Support

Any special needs related to physical, mental, or health conditions may be reported by the candidates to the Internationalisation Office, in order to allow it to request, where feasible, additional financial support to cover the expenses of the student, and/or any accompanying person.

These supports may also be used to co-finance the costs of preparatory visits.

The procedure for applying for this additional financial support, as well as the needed supporting documents, will be communicated to students concerned by the competent Office.

### § 6 – Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible candidates for an ERASMUS+ Mobility for Study under the 2024 edition, SNS students must:

1. Be enrolled at the SNS at the second, third and fourth year of a “corso ordinario” or at the first, second and third year of “corso di perfezionamento” at the moment of the application;
2. Plan a physical mobility in a country different from Italy;
3. Possess adequate language skills (see [§8](#) “Language Requirements”);



4. Submit a study plan illustrating the activities to be performed at the host institution (see [§10](#) “Activities to Be Carried Out Abroad and Learning Agreement”);
5. Obtain the approval of the teacher in charge of the study plan (for students of the “corsi ordinary”) or the course coordinator (for Ph.D. students);
6. Commit to NOT graduate before the end of the mobility and the recognition of the activities carried out abroad.

It is possible to apply for more than one destination indicating an order of preference.

### § 7 - Incompatibilities

Under the ERASMUS+ Programme, students may activate mobilities for study, or for traineeship, during any study cycle (first- and second-level degree and Ph.D.) for a total duration that must not exceed twelve months in each cycle. Any earlier mobility activated in the same cycle must be taken into account for this calculation, with the only exception of virtual mobilities.

Successful candidates cannot activate, during the same period of an Erasmus+ mobility, any other kind of mobility offered by the Scuola.

Erasmus+ students benefiting from the EU grant cannot receive, during the same period, any other type of funds from the European Union.

### § 8 – Language Requirements

Potential candidates for an Erasmus+ mobility are required to check the language requirements set by the host institution of their choice and listed in [Annex A](#), in order to be ready to meet them before departure.

When submitting their application, students may demonstrate to possess an adequate level in the language required either by attaching a language certificate or by self-declaration.

### § 9 - Destinations

Erasmus+ mobilities can be activated towards any institution listed in [Annex A](#), which contains all the details regarding eligible study areas, number and type of positions available, and language requirements.

N.B.: Regardless of the approval of an Erasmus application by the SNS, it is still possible for successful candidates to be rejected by the institution of their choice. This may depend on different factors (deadlines not met, unconfirmed language skills, impractical study plans). Requirements may differ year by year and each host institution reserves the right to accept or reject an application.

## § 10 – Activities to Be Carried Out Abroad and Learning Agreement

In order to benefit from the status of Erasmus student, and from the relative grant, a specific Erasmus+ study plan (known as Learning Agreement) must be approved by the host institution before the beginning of the mobility. Learning Agreements must be redacted online through the [OLA platform](#) or the [Erasmus App](#).

The Learning Agreement must be reviewed and approved in advance by the study plan supervisor or the Ph.D. course coordinator of each candidate. Any activities to be carried out abroad must be included in the SNS study plan within the deadlines for its approval.

At the end of the mobility, any activities performed, courses attended and exams given abroad will be recognised based on the certification submitted.

Upon request, it is possible to make changes to the Learning Agreement while the mobility is in progress, as long as any changes are previously agreed with all the parts involved.

Students of the “Corsi ordinari” (Bachelor’s and Master’s) of the Faculties of Humanities and Sciences may plan activities to be recognised on their study curriculum at the University of Pisa only for those destinations that have signed a specific multilateral agreement with the Scuola and the University, as indicated in [Annex A](#). Recognition of the activities by the University is not automatic but must be authorised in advance by the CAI of the relevant Department.

## § 11 – Documentation to be Submitted at the End of the Mobility

At the end of the mobility, Erasmus+ students have up to 5 weeks to submit the Presence Statement signed and stamped by the host institution, and complete with the actual dates of mobility. They must also prove to have requested the Transcript of Records.

Recognition of any activities performed abroad and listed in the Learning Agreement is conditional on the fulfilment of the above requirement. In absence of documentation, any grant already received will have to be reimbursed.

## § 12 – Deadlines and Application Procedure

Applications must be sent online through the SER.SE. platform (please see instructions in [Annex C](#)).

Candidates must attach a motivation letter and a language certificate, which, in this phase, may be replaced by a self-declaration (please see [§ 8](#)).

All applications will be automatically submitted to the approval of a supervisor and will have to be completed by **26 January 2024**.

Only for the destinations listed in [Annex B](#), it is possible to send applications within a later deadline for mobilities in the second semester 2023-24. Only in these cases, applications can be sent by **6 June 2024**.

## § 13 – Selection Criteria

An interfaculty mobility Committee will evaluate all the applications received and create a ranked list for each destination. Mobilities towards countries not associated to the Programme can be assigned up to 20% of the Erasmus+ contribution received by the SNS.

In particular, the award criteria are the following:

- **Up to 70 points out of 100** for the motivations expressed by each candidate in their motivation letter;
- **Up to 30 points out of 100** for the year of enrolment assigned in this way:

Those students who **already benefited from a previous Erasmus+ mobility** during the same study cycle or a previous study cycle will be **deducted 20 points** from the total score.

In the event of a tied score, preference will be given to the youngest candidate.

Multiple applications at second or subsequent position in order of preference will automatically be placed at the end of the ranked list, if the position in first place of preference is assigned.

Applications for a mobility to the École Normale Supérieure in Paris or Lyon and to Dresden Technische Universitaet will not be ranked. Zero-grant positions will be assigned based on the selection for the same destinations already determined by the call for international exchange positions.

## § 14 – Acceptance, Withdrawal, and Replacement

At the end of the procedure, successful candidates will be contacted by the Internationalisation Office, and will have three days to officially accept the position, even via email, and to promptly ask for information about the application procedure for their destination.

Registering as Erasmus+ student in the host institution once selected is the candidate's responsibility and must be done keeping in mind the deadlines set by each partner. Candidates will receive information on said deadlines by the Internationalisation Office.

The list of successful candidates will be published on the SNS website, at the following address <https://www.sns.it/en/international-calls-and-rankings>.

In order to protect each candidate's privacy, the rankings will show the application number randomly assigned by Ser.Se in place of the candidate's name.

## § 15 – Practical Information

SNS students in outgoing mobility are always covered by an insurance policy against accidents and social liability and by an insurance policy granting health coverage abroad offered by the Scuola Normale Superiore. During a mobility in the European Union, students who have one can also use their European Health Insurance Card (known in Italy as TEAM Card).

Depending on their citizenship, some candidates might need a visa to enter their destination country.

Before departure, students are warmly invited to download the [Erasmus+ App](#) for useful information on their destination.
