



CONDITIONS of USE regarding the BIKE SHARING SERVICE of the SCUOLA NORMALE SUPERIORE and the SCUOLA SUPERIORE SANT'ANNA

The Bike Sharing service is a free service offered by the ATI, awarded with the "*Integrated services for management and maintenance of the properties of the Scuola Normale Superiore and the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna*" contract, and is active and available exclusively for students and guest students in the Faedo, Timpano, Terzani and Capitini colleges, who will be entrusted with and responsible for the bikes during their use.

The service is provided with a view to improving the living conditions of the students of the Scuola Normale Superiore and the Scuola Sant'Anna, also through facilitated mobility within the city, using an ecological means.

The bicycles cannot be used for personal purposes, but only for carrying out activities related to one's student status.

Users of the service need to be aware of, accept and comply with the provisions contained in this document.

Art. 1 The service is available every day, including holidays, from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. and is subject to the user's having signed, read and accepted the conditions of use.

Art. 2 Requests can be made on the same day, at the reception desk of the College where the student is housed, after signing a specific form which can also be found online at the website [https://www.sns .it/it/collegi-e-mensa](https://www.sns.it/it/collegi-e-mensa) and subject to availability.

Art. 3 Bicycles must be returned by the users to the porter on duty no later than 10.10 p.m. on the same day (use for more than one day is not permitted). The bikes must be returned to the same College where they were picked up.

Art. 4 Students must use the bicycles in compliance with the current regulations regulating road traffic, of which, by signing the form, they declare that they are well aware.

Art. 5 Any damage to persons, third parties and things during the use of the vehicle is the sole responsibility of the users, who declare themselves, under their own responsibility, to be capable of riding the vehicle.

Art. 6 Users undertake to always lock the bicycle with the appropriate padlock supplied, securing it to a suitable fixed element. Each bicycle is equipped by the SNS with an identification number and corresponding to the one on the padlock key.

Art. 7 In the event of theft of the bicycle, the student is obliged to submit to the SNS a copy of the theft report submitted to the competent authorities. Should the report not be submitted, the SNS will charge the user the cost of the bike, if it is not found.

Art. 8 The porter will ascertain upon return of the bike (delivery of keys) the state of the bike and the integrity of the various parts. Any damage found will be recorded upon return and the costs incurred for the repair will be directly charged to the user of the bike.

Art. 9 If at the end of the day one of the bikes is missing, the student entrusted with the bike will be contacted and charged €150,00 (one hundred and fifty euros/00), the estimated cost of the bike.

We recommend common sense and moderation in using this Service in order to make it accessible to all guests of the Colleges.
